A DAY TO EXPLORE BECOMING A DISTRICT OF SANCTUARY SATURDAY, 23rd March 2019, 10.00am to 3.00pm

Bridging the end of Moving Stories and the beginning of Our Calling as themes for the life of the District, the Social Responsibility Commission is organising a free Conference to explore becoming a District of Sanctuary. Such a move would see us allied with the Cities of Sanctuary movement started by former President of Conference Revd. Dr. Inderjit Bhogal, and would build on work already being done across the district by individual churches, circuits and London boroughs within which we serve. City of Sanctuary UK holds the vision that our nation will be a welcoming place of safety for all. It aims to support the creation of a culture of welcome and inclusion across every sector and sphere of society. It seeks to promote the voices and celebrate the contributions of people seeking sanctuary, and to increase understanding of such people and the difficulties they experience while living in the UK. The SRC believes the churches and circuits within the District are already engaging in this work and that by seeking to share our stories and looking towards developing and shaping our work towards becoming part of the City of Sanctuary UK movement, we might both affirm what is already being done and make a unified statement against the hostile climate. The day will include some exciting speakers, including Ben Margolies the City of Sanctuary UK co-ordinator for the South of England. Tickets through Eventbrite via the District website.
