MCHW response to coronavirus

We are sure that this news will come as a disappointment, however, we hope you will understand our desire to exercise care and concern for all. As soon as we are able, we will resume our normal activities.

A reminder of our guidance on pastoral visiting in care homes, hospitals and homes of poorly people:

Elderly, weak and poorly people are most likely to have low immunity and are least able to fight the coronavirus. For this reason hospitals and care homes are discouraging or even prohibiting visiting. Consequently for the time being our pattern of pastoral care, by both ministers and pastoral leaders, will change. Physical visits will lessen and phone calls to maintain contact and prayer will be used. Friends visiting friends in the congregation must do so with care and mutual agreement.

The team is working hard to enable us to continue to worship together as a community, as best we can. This may be through streaming via the internet or by providing resources so that we can worship at home, or aspects of both. We are working to see if it is possible to have a prayer space open in the chapel. Further information will become available on the website and via social media.

Finally, let us continue to support one another as a Church family at this time. Remembering to keep in touch with one another and pray for each other and the world.
